Bird Walk:

Join a naturalist-birder. Easy stroll. Meet at the Mono Lake County Park (5 miles north of Lee Vining just east of Hwy 395). 1½-2 hours

Dig Into Dana Walk:

Geology & history bloom like corn lilies in the mind on this Yosemite Park Ranger guided walk. Meet at Tioga Pass Entrance Station. 1½ hours

Lundy Canyon Walk:

Guided Walk on mining and natural history. Meet at Historical Marker at Lundy Resort. 1½ hours

Junior Ranger Walk:

Meet at the Mono Lake County Park (5 miles North of Lee Vining off Cemetery Rd.) Bring a snack. 1½ hours

Bennettville Walk:

Natural & Human history walk with a Yosemite Park Ranger to Bennettville. Meet at Junction Campground. 1½ -2 hours

South Tufa Walk:

Discover the mystery of Mono Lake's strange water. Meet at the South Tufa Kiosk (5 miles east of Hwy 395 on Hwy 120). 1½ hours

Panum Crater Walk:

Come explore one of North America's youngest volcanoes and explore the volcano's secrets. Meet at Panum Crater Parking Area. 1 hour. (Last Walk Aug. 9th)

Stars Over Mono Lake:

Meet at South Tufa Kiosk. Bring something to sit on & warm clothes. 1½ hours

Visitor Center Patio Talks:

Come join a Naturalist talk on the Mono Basin or Yosemite National Park. 20 mins.

"Why Care For A Bear?":

Join a Yosemite Park Ranger to learn about the behavior & biology of the American Black Bear. Meet at Junction Campground. 1½ hours
