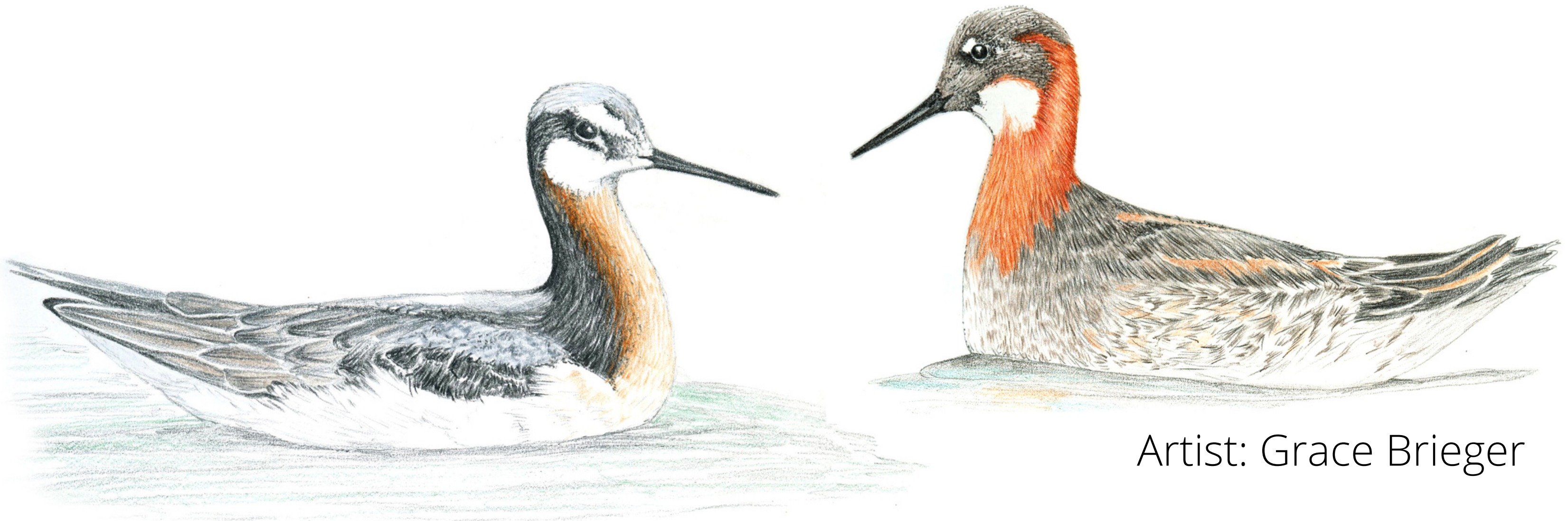


Phalarope Interpretive Walk
